

Meeting with Alan Mann at Slough, Monday 5 April 1965.

1. Programme

The programme (provisionally) will be :

2. Budget

See attached schedule.

Subject to confirmation from Ray Geddes the outstanding 1964 account will be settled by payment of \$30,000 in cash and a credit for \$25,000. Claims for labour and operating expenses will be rendered by Alan Mann and charged against the credit.

Additional income will be a contribution from Ford (\$25,000) and from Castrol (probably \$25,000). The estimated income is therefore \$75,000. Total cost of the programme, as outlined, is estimated at \$93,576.

3. Cars

Two 289 Cobra Coupes will be entered in all races except the T. T. where the entry will consist of one coupe and one Roadster (to be supplied from Ford Advanced Vehicles).

Two cars will be prepared by Shelby and air shipped on or before 16 April. Mr. MacKenzie will arrange for special customs clearance if the cars arrive at Easter. Shelby will advise flight details and airwaybill. The cars will be consigned to Ford Advanced Vehicles, on carnets, with green insurance cards. The carnets will be accompanied by an authority from Shelby as follows :

"Mr. _____ is hereby authorised to sign all customs and shipping documents on our behalf".

The third car will be air shipped on or before 23 April, consigned in the same way.

4.

Parts

The parts inventory will be discussed with Mr. P. Remington when he arrives. An initial parts inventory will be shipped with the cars.

Engines will be covered by separate carnets. All other parts will be on temporary importation, for use as racing car spares. Mr. MacKenzie will arrange a customs bond. The general parts inventory

will be held by Ford Advanced Vehicles. They will be supplied to Alan Mann as required on a consignment invoice and billed firm as they are used.

5. Claim for Operating Expenses

Alan Mann will render to Ford Advanced Vehicles a monthly claim for operating expenses, not later than the fifteenth of the following month. At the same time he will account for parts used.
